



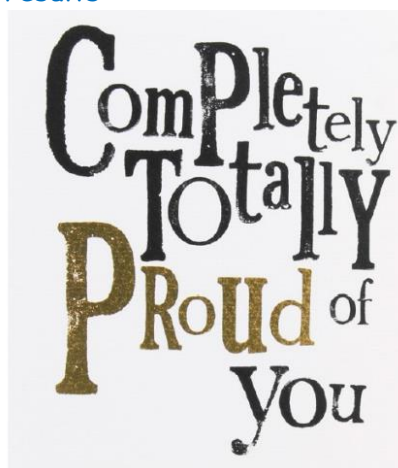

#### Hive Bookings and Breakfast Club

Bookings for The Hive and Breakfast Club will go live on Monday 14<sup>th</sup> July. We will no longer be offering free breakfast club due to the low demand. Breakfast club will be offered Monday - Thursday mornings only. Payment will be made via MCAS.

#### Swimming

Years 3,4 and 5 will swim over the course of next year with non-swimmers from Year 6 joining them. Each class will swim for a term. This will begin with Dolphin class (Year 5) in the Autumn Term, followed by Octopus Class (Year 3) in the Spring Term and then Swordfish Class (Year 4) in the Summer Term.

#### Clubs Autumn term

Bookings will go live for September clubs via Bromcom on Monday 14<sup>th</sup> July at 6pm. Clubs will run throughout the term from September rather than just for 10 weeks. All payments will need to be made at the time of booking and there will be no refunds for absence or a child deciding they no longer want to continue. When you book the year group for your child will be their current one, not the one they will be in September e.g. a KS2 Club will be able to be booked by a current Y2 child as they will be in KS2 in September.



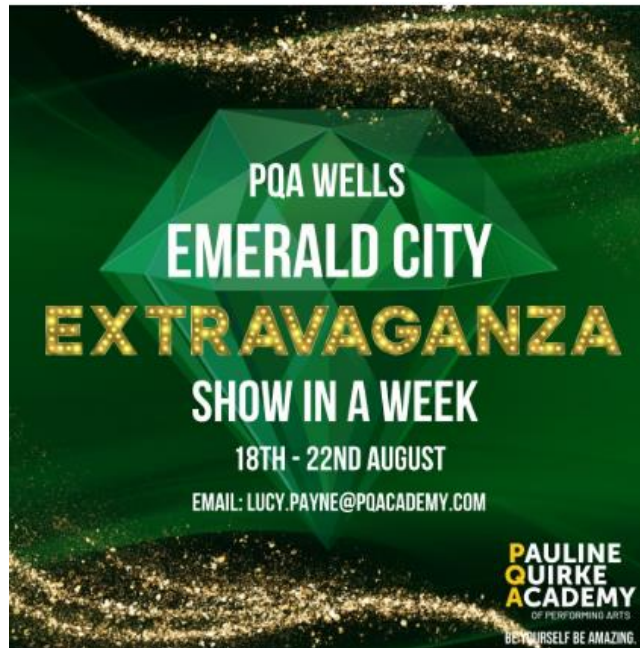

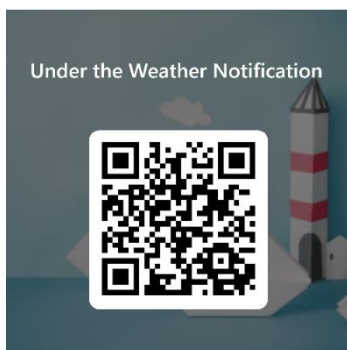
