Attendance

Please can I remind you that school starts at 9:00 and we are open from 8:50am. There are seeing an increasing number of children arriving late to school and this is simply not acceptable or fair on the children who are missing learning every day. Being late to school can have a considerable impact over the whole school year. The table below shows you just how much time can be missed over a year just by being 5 minutes late to school every day:

5 minutes late every day = 3 days of school lost a year 10 minutes late every day = 6.5 days of school lost a year 15 minutes late every day = 10 days of school lost a year 20 minutes late every day = 13 days of school lost a year 30 minutes late every day = 19 days of school lost a year

We understand that the school mornings can be hectic, but when your child is late for school they are missing out on vital parts of their education.
